KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

That we *Milham L. Boucsein and Robert Moody*
are firmly hold and bound unto *Joseph Hastell* —
Governor and Commander in Chief of the State of Delaware, in
the sum of *five* hundred pounds, good and lawful money of
America, to be paid to the said *Joseph Hastell* —
Esq. or his successors; to the which payment well and truly to
be made, we bind ourselves, jointly and severally, for and in the
whole, our heirs, executors and administrators, firmly by these
presents... Sealed with our seals... Dated the *eleventh* - day of
March in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight
hundred and *eighteen*.

The Condition of this Obligation is such, That
if there shall hereafter appear any lawful let or impediment,
by reason of any pre-contract, consanguinity, affinity, or any other
just cause, what so ever, that the above mentioned *Milham L.
Boucsein and Robert Moody*

may lawfully marry; and that there is not any suit depending
before any judge ecclesiastical or civil, for or concerning any such
pre-contract; and also if the said parties, and each of them, are of
the ages following: to wit, female of eighteen, and male of twenty-
one years; and are not under the tuition of his or her parents, or
have the full consent of his or her parents or guardians respectively
to the said marriage, and if they or either of them are not indentured
servants; and do and shall save harmless and keep indemnified
the above named *Joseph Hastell* — Esq. and
his successors, for and concerning the premises; and shall likewise
save harmless and keep indemnified the clergyman or minister who
shall join the said parties in matrimony, for or by reason of his
so doing... then this obligation to be void, or else to stand and
remain in full force and virtue.
